## **ATTORNEY'S CORNER**

Guess this is Part II of the octane story.

Most engine management systems commonly found in automobiles today (typically EFI-Electronic Fuel Injection) have a knock sensor that monitors if knock is being produced by the fuel being used. In modern computer-controlled engines, the ignition timing will be automatically altered by the engine management system to reduce the knock to an acceptable level.

Whether or not a higher octane fuel improves or impairs an engine's performance depends on the design of the engine. Fuels with a higher octane rating are used in higher-compression gasoline engines, which may yield higher power for these engines. The higher power comes from the fuel's higher compression by the engine design, and not directly from the gasoline. Think race cars! Here is a good Jeopardy question; What has the chemical formula C8H18. Answer: What is Octane?

Fuels with lower octane (but higher cetane numbers which indicate the combustion speed of diesel fuel) are ideal for diesel engines because diesel engines, also called compression-ignition engines, do not compress the fuel, but rather compress only air and then inject fuel into the air that was heated by compression. Gasoline engines rely on ignition of air and fuel compressed together as a mixture, which is ignited near the end of the compression stroke by electric spark plugs. Therefore, high compressibility of the fuel matters mainly for gasoline engines.

The octane rating of aviation gasoline was extremely important in determining aero engine performance in the aircraft of World War II. The octane rating alone did not only determine the performance of the gasoline, but also the versatility of the fuel in handling a range of lean to rich operating conditions.

# **EMPLOYEE RETENTION CREDIT**

There are four ways to qualify for the ERC.

- Full or Partial Suspension shut down due to government order (order did not have to be given directly to you), applies mainly during 2020 since there were very few shutdowns during 2021.
- 2. Supply Chain Disruption must have resulted from a government order to your supplier, making them unable to deliver goods to you.
- 3. Revenue Reduction 2020- 50% reduction of gross sales compared to same quarter of 2019; 2021-20% reduction of gross sales compared to same quarter of 2019.
- Start Up Recovery Funds Started business after 2/15/20.

There are no up-front costs to apply!!! If and only if you get a credit back from the treasury, there will be a 15% recovery fee off of the total amount returned.

If you qualify you may be eligible for up to \$26,000.00 per W-2 employee. You can still receive your credit if you got the PPP.

It takes a few minutes to fill out the application. If you prequalify, you can move on to the regular application and begin the process for your rebate.

In 2 to 4 weeks, you will have an answer from Tax Rebate Specialists on the amount of your rebate!

# MASSACHUSETTS ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ENFORCE RIGHT TO REPAIR LAW

Massachusetts Atty General Andrea Campbell is moving forward, despite the lack of a decision by a federal court, with implementing the Right to Repair law passed by voters in 2020.

On March 7, Campbell filed a "notice of intent to terminate nonenforcement stipulation" as of June 1, meaning she will take action to implement the law.

The Attorney General's Office had suspended enforcement of the law pending the results of the court case, which has been repeatedly delayed for more than two years.

The Massachusetts Right to Repair Coalition thanked Campbell for her decision. "On behalf of all Massachusetts independent repair shops and 4,000 members statewide, we thank Attorney General Campbell for standing with the voters and their right to get their car fixed wherever they choose as automakers increasingly try to create a monopoly in the car repair market," said Tommy Hickey, executive director of the Right to Repair Coalition. "It has been more than two years since Massachusetts voters approved Right to Repair by a 75-25 margin and the Attorney General's action is a breath of fresh air for consumers and the independent auto repair market.


"During this delay, the automobile manufacturers have been unfairly steering new customers to their franchised dealerships, and consumers are losing," Hickey continued. "We urge the federal court to finally rule in this case and appreciate the attorney general's action moving forward."

In her court filing, Campbell said: "The attorney general has a specific statutory duty to issue the notice provided for under Section 4 of the Data Access Law---a statutory command approved by 75% of Massachusetts voters over two years ago---as well as more general statutory and common-law duties to defend and enforce the laws of the Commonwealth.

"After consideration of these competing concerns, the Attorney General has determined that the non-enforcement stipulation should soon come to an end. Accordingly, the attorney general respectfully notifies this court that the non-enforcement stipulation will terminate effective June 1, 2023, and that she will issue the notice required by Section 4 of the Data Access Law shortly thereafter."
