Our Scholarship Committee is excited to inform you and your employees of our 2024 academic scholarships. This year, NETSA and our Scholarship Sponsors are awarding Nineteen \$2000 Scholarships. In 2023, NETSA exceeded \$500,000 in scholarship awards for our members, member employees, and their families. As a result, we would like to announce that in celebrating this milestone, we awarded a \$5000 scholarship selected from a random drawing of our 2023 NETSA Scholarship recipients. Your employees, their spouses, and dependents are eligible to win one of these wonderful scholarships. #### NETSA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Only employees and dependents of employees from the NETSA primary membership location who have paid their dues in full are eligible to apply for NETSA scholarships. If that member has additional locations and the employee works at that location, then secondary dues must be paid for that additional store by the scholarship application deadline.
- 2. To qualify, employees must be employed for at least two (2) years at the NETSA member location.
- 3. Only the primary employee and the dependents of the employee listed as the contact name for a manufacturer are eligible to apply for NETSA scholarships. Manufacturer's secondary members are also eligible if dues are paid in full for both the primary and secondary memberships by the scholarship application deadline. Separate company subsidiaries require that full dues be paid for that member to be eligible for NETSA scholarships.
- 4. Scholarship applicants must comply with all requirements of the NETSA scholarship application and must have their fully completed paperwork postmarked by the yearly deadline, established by the scholarship committee, to be eligible for consideration.
- 5. These are NETSA post-secondary scholarships, only high school seniors or those who are attending or planning to attend a post-secondary school full or part time are eligible to apply that calendar year. The checks issued by NETSA will only be issued jointly in the name of the winner and the institution to which the winner is attending or planning to attend. If that person does not end up attending that institution, then the check will revert to NETSA and the scholarship committee will meet to determine whether to defer the awarding of the scholarship or to pick another winner in conjunction with the sponsor of that scholarship.
- 6. Dependents of NETSA member employees for the purposes of the NETSA Scholarship Fund are defined as a current spouse, children or stepchildren who reside at least part-time at the home of that employee during that calendar year and meet the IRS definition of a dependent.
- 7. The NETSA scholarship committee reserves the right to reject applicants if any of the above requirements are not met.
