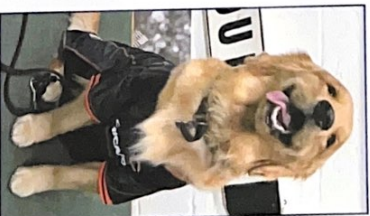

On behalf of the veterans we serve, please accept our heartfelt thanks for your support.


